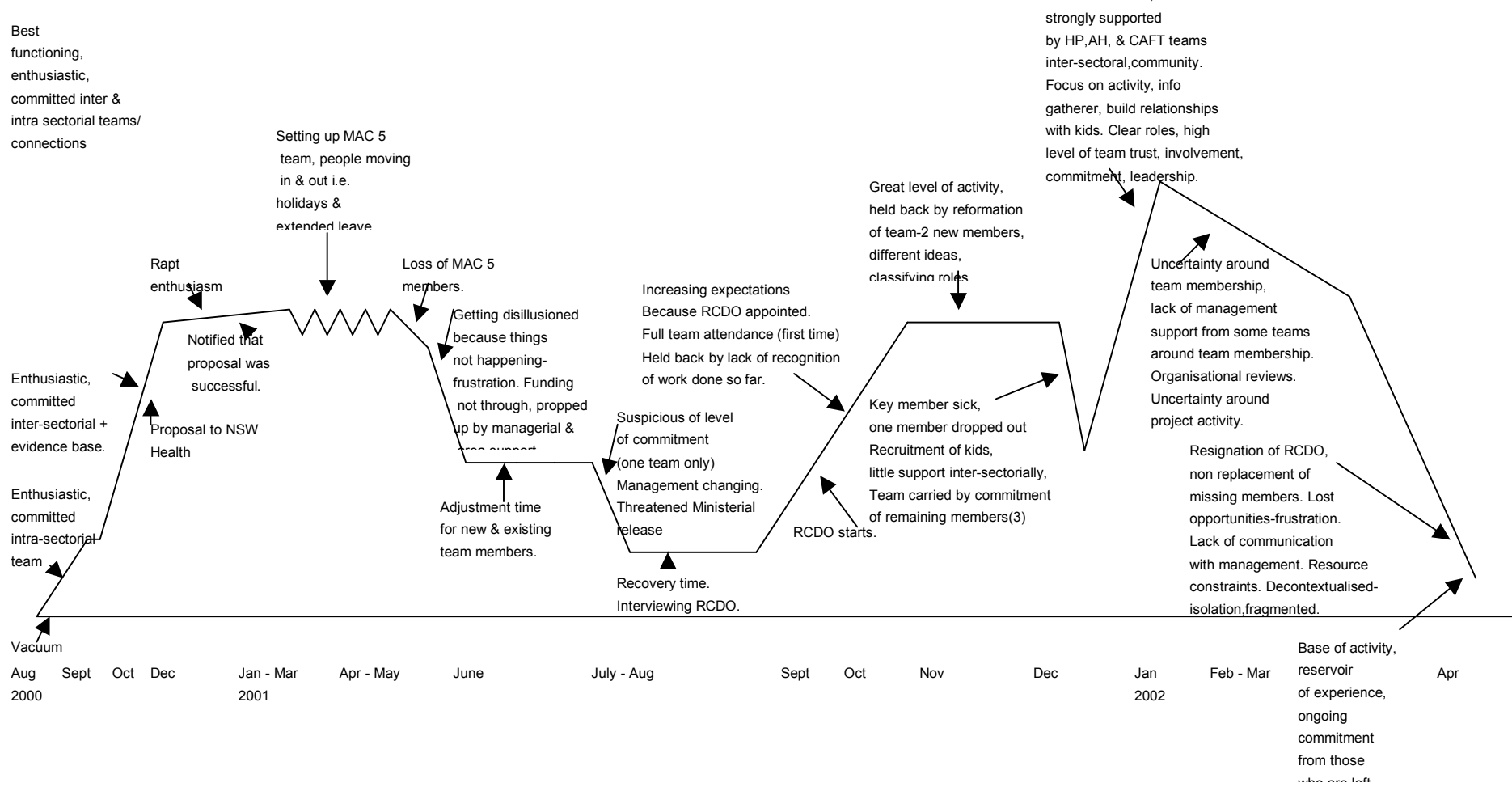


Figure 1: Change Graph 1 April 2000 - April 2002

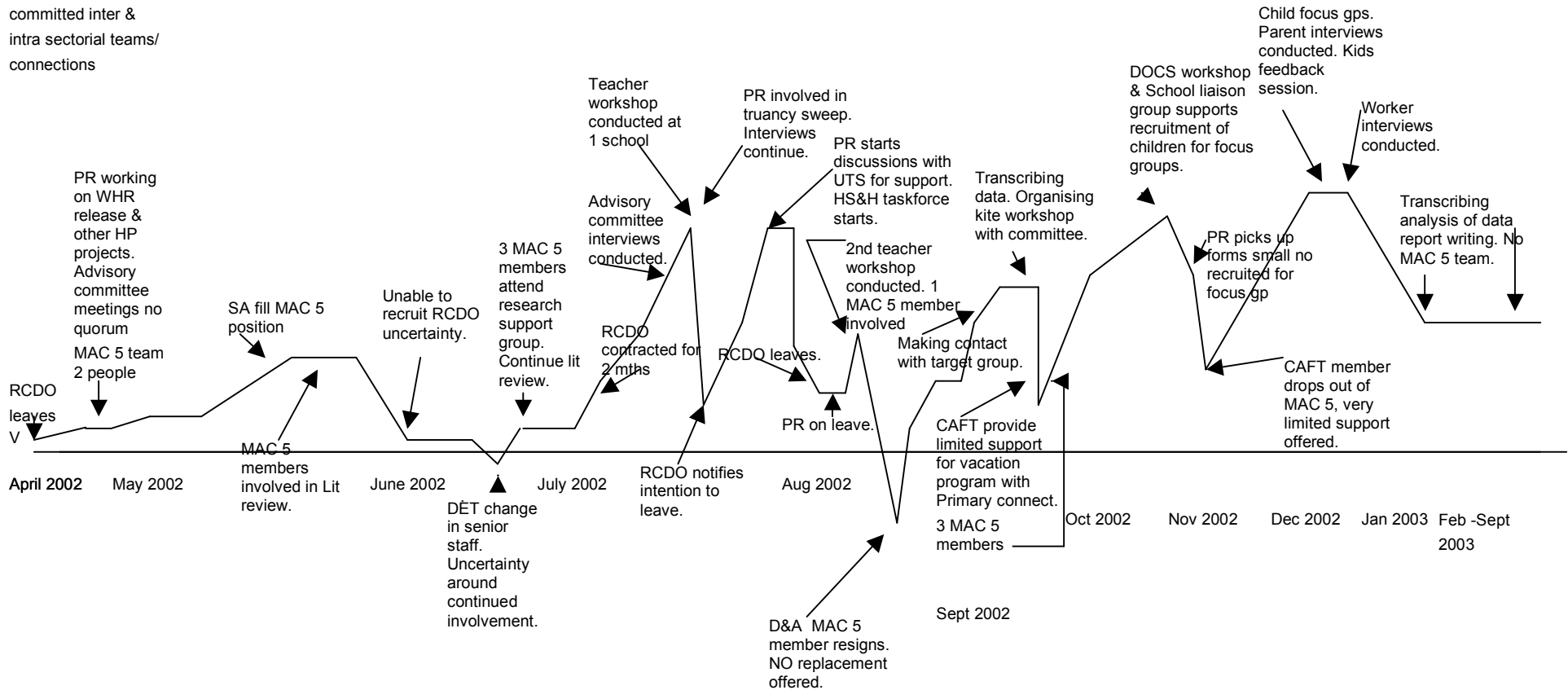


Figure 1: Change Graph 1 April 2000 - April 2002
